Post-Graduate Certificate in Supervision of Applied Psychological Practice

Teaching & assessment methods

Teaching consists of lectures, tutorials and a monthly Supervision of Supervision group. Teaching takes place monthly on a Wednesday at the Isis Education Centre, Warneford Hospital in Oxford (apart from the first 2 days of the course which are consecutive –on a Tuesday and Wednesday)

The assessment methods for the PGCert in Supervision of Applied Psychological Practice are as follows:-

Formative assessment

In advance of the summative assessments listed below, students will be required to submit a 2,000 word critique of a therapy model of supervision, which they will present in a tutorial session. Students will receive feedback on their submission, but this will not form part of the PGCert award.

Summative assessment

- 4,000 word essay on an aspect of supervision covered in the curriculum
- Submission of recording of supervision with 2,000 word critical commentary, and an outcome measure of the supervisory relationship
- 3,000 reflective log of supervision practice and learning and development as a supervisor, and a record of their supervisory practice signed by their supervisor

Additionally, students are required to attend a minimum of 10 of the 13 teaching days and to carry out a minimum of 40 hours of supervision for the award of the PGCert.
